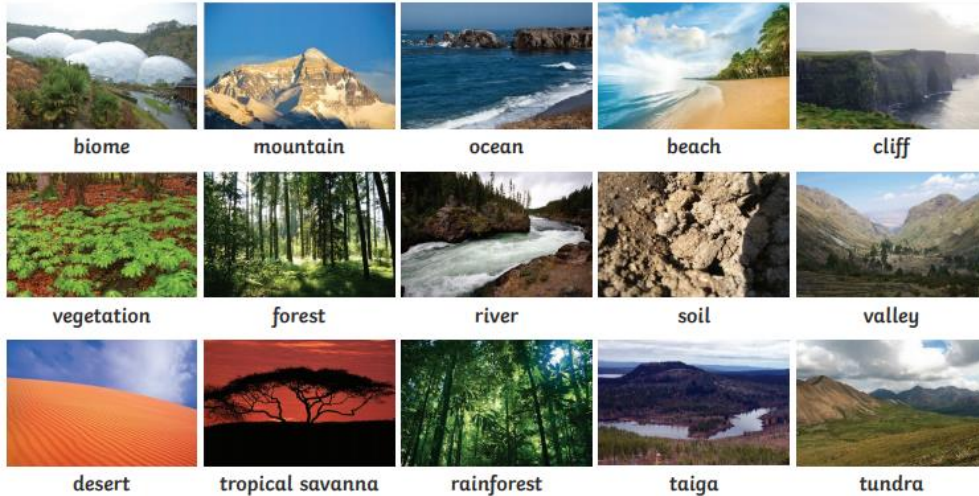


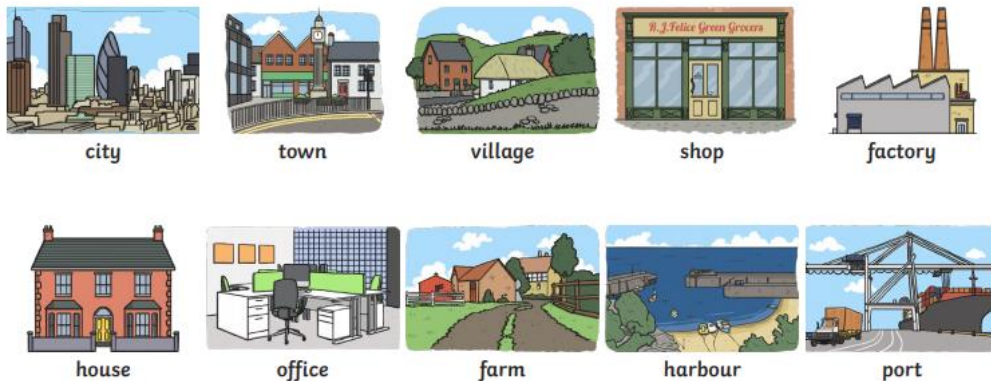

Continents and Oceans

Continents – a large land mass that can be separated by oceans, however many continents are connected i.e – Asia, Europe and Africa.

Oceans – a very large expanse of sea. Oceans cover 70% of the Earth's surface.

Modes of Transport
