Key Vocabulary	
City	A large town that usually has a cathedral.
Town	a large group of houses, shops and buildings where people live and work. Towns are larger than villages but smaller than cities.
Farm	An area of land used to produce crops or to breed animals' and livestock.
Factory	Where goods are made in large quantities.
House	A building designed for people to live in.
Office	A building of rooms where business and work is carried out by office workers.
Port	A town or city with a harbour or access to water where ships can load and unload.
Harbour	A place on the coast where ships may moor in shelter.
Shop	A building in which goods are sold. Examples - supermarkets, clothes shops and toy shops.
