

HURLEY PRIMARY SCHOOL ARRANGEMENTS FROM MONDAY 6th SEPTEMBER 2021

All children will return to Hurley Primary School on Monday 6th September.

We hope to return to much more normal times

- There will be no staggered starts to the day
- Children will not be required to stay in their class bubbles.
- Parents can return to the school playground to drop off and collect children

However, some basic Covid Control Measures Will Still Remain In Place.

We will still maintain some Covid control measures to reduce chances the children, staff and parents catching Covid and consequently missing further periods of time off school.

REMAINING COVID CONTROLS FROM SEPTEMBER 21

- If children are poorly, keep them off school to reduce the general spread of infections.
- If children have Covid Symptoms keep them off school and get them a PCR test. If this PCR result is positive contact school immediately and self- isolate.
- Children will be encouraged to wash their hands regularly during the day.
- We will ensure the school is well ventilated.
- Initially we have been advised by Warwickshire Local Authority NOT to hold large indoor gatherings like whole school assemblies or big indoor events however this will advise will be reviewed during this term. Therefore, in the first few weeks we will have smaller key stage assemblies to spread children out better in the hall.
- When collecting children please try to maintain sensible social distancing by respecting other parents' personal space and try, where possible, to avoid congregating in large groups.
- Masks are recommended by the Local Authority, but they are not compulsory.
- If parents enter school for a specific meeting, please wear a mask (unless medically exempt)

Arriving at school - All children should arrive at school between 8.45 -8.55 am.

Children arriving after 8.55 will be marked as late.

Parents will be allowed to enter the school playground to drop off their children. Wearing of masks and social distancing will be a matter of personal choice although we do ask everyone to be considerate of others.

Children must be dropped off outside the school building and parents MUST NOT ENTER SCHOOL with their children. Staff will be placed at the Infant class entrances to greet the children. On the first day back, Junior staff will be on the playground to welcome children in.

FOR SAFEGUARDING AND SECURITY REASONS, PARENTS AND OTHER ADULTS MUST NOT ENTER THE SCHOOL BUILDING THEY MUST ONLY ENTER THE SCHOOL BUILDING VIA THE SCHOOL OFFICE WITH PRIOR PERMISSION TO DO SO. PLEASE DO NOT FOLLOW YOUR CHILD INTO SCHOOL.

Infant parents: Reception, Year 1 and Year 2

Infant parents will drop off children to their 'class gates' which are by the school playground. A member of staff will be at each class gate to greet you.

Junior Children Year 3, Year4, Year5, Year6

Junior children will enter school via the Hall door entrance.

Staff from each year group will be on the playground to greet the children.

Children in Year 5 and Year 6 can walk independently to and from school, if given permission by their parents.

We will be allowing children in Years 5 and Year 6 to walk independently to and from school. ***This is providing parents have completed a permission form using the following link***

Leaving School - From September all children will finish school at 3.30 pm

Parents can wait for the children on the school playground at the end of the afternoon.
The school gate will be opened at 3.20 pm to enable parents access to the playground

Infant children must be collected from their class gates by parents/carers or a trusted adult (please notify school beforehand if another adult is collecting your child)

Year 3 and 4 should be collected from the playground by parents or a trusted adult

Year 5 and 6 can walk home independently if they have been given permission by their parents using the form (see Walking Home Consent link <https://forms.gle/cCcd3ogn42sBunEb9>)

Please ensure you arrive on time to pick up your child from school.

If for some reason you cannot arrive at school on time, please notify the school office as soon as possible so childcare arrangements can be put in place.

If a Junior children 's parents do not arrive at 3.30 pm to pick up on the school playground the child should return to the school office immediately where their parents can be contacted or alternative arrangements can be made to provide childcare for them while their parents or a responsible adult arrives at school.

PARKING ARRANGEMENTS

We continue to encourage and recommend that where possible children and parents walk to and from school. This is a great way to help children develop healthy behaviours for the future and exercise is great for everyone's mental health.

However, walking to school isn't possible for all families. From September, the church carpark will be made available for parking again as parents will not be required to line up at the school entrance.

Please note:

- People use the church car park **at their own risk.**
- The car park will not hold all the cars so some parents will have to continue to park away from the school.

WHEN PARKING, PLEASE SHOW CONSIDERATION TO OTHERS INCLUDING OUR NEIGHBOURS AND ALWAYS BE MINDFUL OF THE SAFETY OF OUR CHILDREN.
